- ▶ SPACEECONOMY project will develop a national roadmap that outlines how Finland's space economy can grow in a sustainable and inclusive way by:
 - ▶ using space-related technologies
 - ▶ supporting sustainable business opportunities, and
 - ▶ developing policies and decision-making approaches that can respond to future challenges.
- ▶ The work will be carried out in Work Package 4: Sustainable governance for space economy
 - ▶ WP4 develops the policies, governance, and investment approaches needed to support a sustainable, inclusive, and internationally competitive space economy in Finland.
 - ▶ Building on the business models and economic insights developed in e.g. WP3, WP4 expands the focus to the broader space ecosystem and society.



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- ▶ The roadmap will
 - ▶ be co-created with stakeholders from government, industry, academia, and civil society;
 - ▶ bring together findings from all consortium activities;
 - ▶ provide recommendations on regulation, investment, innovation, and preparedness for future disruptions;
 - ▶ align with Finland's updated space strategy and international sustainability goals, including the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs);
 - ▶ incorporate perspectives from different regions and stakeholder groups to support inclusive policymaking.
